

There, as cycles and even a couch on wheels and a motor prowled the racetrack, the giant music tent and smaller tents of vendors got busier as the sun fell lower. Campers dotted the surrounding trees while cyclists looked over every kind of leather and motorcycle part.

"I restore old bikes so I'm just scavenging through looking for parts," said Bob McCormick of Kennan, Wis. as he smiled and dug through box after box at the swap meet. "I've got a '49, a '59 a '79 and a '46. I'm always looking for parts."

Across the town bikers freely approached each other to ask about their machines and to exchange stories. The bikes themselves could be seen on every road in the county and heard well off those roads. Aaron Evans lives five miles east of Tomahawk with his family and came in for a brief visit Friday to watch the Thunder Parade, an 18-mile long parade with thousands of motorcycles. "It's good to see them, but it's good to have them go, too," he said, considering how congested traffic sometimes got. "You bypass town," he suggested.
